

# Minor Hockey Association of Lambeth



Lambeth Minor Hockey is planning to have both a Tyke and a Mite program this coming season. Both programs will run approximately 24 weeks beginning in early October. Players in both programs must wear full equipment.

**\*\* A photocopy of each player's birth certificate must be provided at registration.**

**\*\* Lambeth Minor Hockey has set a minimum number of players for the Mite program. The decision to proceed with the Mite program will be made on or before June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009. If minimum Mite registrations are not met, all 4 year old registrants will be given the opportunity to play in the Tyke league (and pay balance of fees) or receive a full refund. Registrants who are 3 years old will be given a full refund. Registrants who are 3 year olds will not be allowed into the Tyke program.**

**This decision will be made on or before June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009.**

## **Mite Hockey Program**

- AGE: Open to children 3 and 4 years old (birth years 2005 and 2006)
- COST: \$200 Mite hockey players will not be charged a volunteer or fundraising fee.
- One hour of ice time per week on Saturday mornings. Emphasis will be on having fun, skating and hockey basics. The hour will be spent practicing skating and doing drills. Short scrimmages may be played at the end of each session as players progress.
- Players will be separated into teams that will play on divided ice.
- Coaches will be contacted by the end of May.

## **Tyke Hockey Program**

- AGE: Open to children 5 and 6 years old (birth years 2003 and 2004)
- COST: \$475
- Two hours of ice time per week. Tyke games are played Saturday mornings. Tyke practices are held Monday or Tuesday at 4:30 pm depending on team assignment. Each team practices on the same night throughout the season. There are no playoffs.
- A skills assessment will be conducted at the beginning of the season. A draft will be held at the Lambeth Community Center. Players will meet their coaches, teammates, receive their jersey, socks and their team schedule at this event.
- Players will be divided onto four balanced teams based on the skills assessment. A few players may be traded at mid season with league, coach and parental consent if it is found that the teams are very unbalanced.
- A referee is provided for each game. Penalties and off-sides will be called as the season progresses.
- Lambeth Minor Hockey hosts a Tyke Hockey Tournament on the Tuesday of March Break.
