2009-2010 Fundraising Fee

Effective the 2009-2010 hockey seasons we are implementing a fundraising fee of \$100.00 per family. This is consistent with the majority of other Shamrock teams in our league. Dorchester, Lambton Shores, Strathroy, Mt. Brydges , Lucan , St. Mary's, Port Stanley, Thamesford and Ilderton all charge a fundraising fee in the amounts between \$50.00 and \$255.00 with the average being \$105.50. (based on 2007/02008 registration information).

How will it work?

We will be assigning each family twenty \$5.00 raffle tickets to be handed out to each family [early in the hockey season for a draw to follow](#). The proceeds will go to the families that sell these tickets as they will have already paid Lambeth Minor Hockey for these tickets at registration.

Why now?

The cost of ice this year is going up another 5% which will bring the cost of our ice rental this upcoming season to almost \$220,000.00. The LMHA executive decided that instead of increasing registration fees this year, that we would implement this fundraising fee. The proceeds of this raffle will help offset the ice increase for the 2009-2010 hockey season. This gives the families who choose to, the opportunity to play hockey for the same registration fee for last year. This will be the only "draw" that Lambeth Minor Hockey will be doing this year. We have had a draw the last few years except now the people who choose to participate will receive a benefit towards their registration.

We hope that all Lambeth Hockey families appreciate we are trying our best to control our registration costs in a not so rosy economic environment. If you have any questions please feel free to contact me.
